The Light, Aesthetics & Noise subcommittee has been established to help PCAC fulfill its mission, as established by Mayor Hahn and the Harbor Commission, by focusing on Light, Aesthetics and Noise (LAN) issues, including the following steps:

1. **To assess individual and cumulative impacts from Port operations on LAN by completing a baseline study and other data collection means;**
2. To set priorities and make recommendations concerning the results of LAN studies;
3. **To evaluate existing LAN Thresholds of Significance and to make recommendations regarding Harbor Department environmental assessment of LAN impacts;**
4. To evaluate and recommend potential LAN mitigation measures;
5. To draft policies and amendments to Port planning documents with respect to LAN;
6. To work with Harbor Department staff to review and make improvements to design, operation and maintenance practices of the Department with respect to LAN;
7. To participate with other PCAC subcommittees in identifying, planning and participating in Harbor Department beautification projects;
8. To carry out any other studies and make recommendations on issues within the scope of LAN impacts and issues.
